TITLE IX MAILING TO SCHOOLS

The is a reminder that the KHSAA recently mailed the following forms to all member schools.

These forms are to be submitted for the 2000-2001 school year not later than April 15, 2001.

1. Form GE-19 (KHSAA Annual Verification of Title IX Procedures)
2. Forms T-1 through T-4 (Summary Forms for Determining Student Interests and Abilities)
3. Form T-41 (Checklist for the Overall Interscholastic Athletics Program)
4. Form T-60 (Updated Corrective Action Plan)
5. Form T-63 (Summary of the Interscholastic Student Interest Survey)

NOTE: Single-sex schools are not required to submit the forms.

DELEGATE VOTING RESULTS

A record 243 voting delegates were in attendance at the KHSAA annual meeting of member schools held Tues., Jan. 9, at the Hyatt Regency in Lexington.

SWEET 16® TOURNAMENT DRAWS

The draw for the both the 2001 KHSAA Boys' & Girls' Sweet 16® State Basketball Tournaments will be held Fri., Feb. 2.

Again, WKYT-TV in Lexington will air the draw of both tournaments live as a part of its *After Noon* news program at 12:30 p.m. (ET). WKYT-TV is making the program available to TV stations from across the state. Satellite coordinators are: SBS6, transponder 18 upper. The feed will be available beginning at 12:30 p.m. (ET) and continue until 1 p.m. The draw will also be broadcast over the internet through the KHSAA's partner, kentucky.com. Complete tournament brackets will be posted on the KHSAA website at the conclusion of the program.

The Boys' State Tournament is scheduled for March 14-17, at Rupp Arena in Lexington. The Girls' State Tournament is scheduled for March 21-24 at Western Kentucky University's E.A. Diddle Arena in Bowling Green. Tickets to both tournaments are currently on sale through the KHSAA office (Visa/Mastercard) by calling (859) 299-5472, or through the KHSAA Internet site (www.khsaa.org).

BASKETBALL TEAM PICTURES

This is a reminder that boys' and girls' basketball team pictures are due, as printed in the 2000-2001 KHSAA memo calendar, to the Association by Fri., Feb. 2, 2001.

Again, xeroxed copies of pictures or tear-sheets from your game programs are not acceptable. Scanned pictures must be at 300 dpi and saved with a file extension of .gif, .tif, or .gif.

THREE-PERSON OFFICIATING

The KHSAA reminds member schools that there is no requirement or mandate to use three officials at any time for basketball games during the regular season. However, three officials will be used in boy's and girl's district, regional and state tournament competitions.

In addition, in accordance with the KHSAA Handbook, the district game fee for each of three officials is \$40 per game. Regional tournament officiating fees are \$45 per official. Twenty cents per round trip mile is allowed for one car per game with no hook-up mileage allowed. Assigning secretaries (and not game officials) will be providing tournament managers with specific game fee/mileage fee information for tournament assigned officials.

SOFTBALL SCHOOLS

This is a reminder to member schools that you are to inform the KHSAA as to your intent to play slow pitch softball, fast pitch softball or both for the coming 2001 season.

Schools should notify the KHSAA (Attention Asst. Commissioner Larry Boucher) by FAX (859-293-5999) their intention to play slow pitch softball only or both slow and fast pitch.

It will be assumed that if a school played fast pitch during the 2000 season they will be playing fast pitch again during the upcoming 2001 season. If a school did not play fast pitch last season (2000), and intends to play fast pitch in the 2001 season, the school should also make notification to the KHSAA of this intent. The KHSAA should be notified of member school's softball team(s) intentions no later than January 15, 2001.

SCHOLAR ATHLETE OF THE GAME

LG&E in sponsorship of the Boys' & Girls' Sweet 16® Statewide Radio Network, will again be recognizing two athletes during each game of both tournaments as "Scholar Athletes of the Game".

This is a recognition program that is promoted over the network with the honorees receiving a certificate following the tournaments. The program is not limited to basketball players and each school may nominate as many athletes in any sport.

More information and a blank form is included in this mailing. All nominations are to be returned to the KHSAA by Friday, March 2.
