KHSAA BOARD OF CONTROL MEETING

The Kentucky High School Athletic Association Board of Control is scheduled to meet Sept. 16-17 at the KHSAA Office in Lexington. This is a regularly scheduled meeting. For an agenda, contact the KHSAA office.

The Board will review Danville's appeal of forfeiture of its first two football contests at its special October meeting. The Board will review communication regarding the draft basketball alignment at its November meeting. Member schools have until Oct. 15 to respond with comments regarding the draft alignment.

GOLF REGIONAL SITES

Boys' & girls' regional golf tournament sites and managers have been posted on the KHSAA website. Regional tournaments are scheduled for Sat., 25 through Tues., Sept. 28. The Leachman Buick/GMC – KHSAA State Golf Championships are scheduled for the following week in Bowling Green. The girls' tournament will be Oct. 5-6 at the Bowling Green Country Club. The boys' tournament will be Oct. 7-8 at the Indian Hills Country Club. State Championship Round 1 tee times will be posted on the Association website on Friday, Oct. 1.

STATE VOLLEYBALL BRACKET

The draw for the 2004 KHSAA State Volleyball Tournament is set. The event is scheduled for Oct. 29-30 and will be played at the Frankfort Convention Center. New to the tournament this year is a "one court" schedule of the event. Previous tournaments used a "two court" set-up for Friday's first round and Saturday morning's quarterfinals.

BASKETBALL DRAFT ALIGNMENT

The KHSAA Board of Control, after a two year study, approved a draft alignment to be sent out to member schools. The proposed alignment would be adopted beginning with the 2005-06 season. The draft alignment was mailed to member schools on Sept. 1 and released on the KHSAA website on Sept. 2. Schools may provide input as directed with correspondence received to be presented to the Board at its November meeting.

During the process, the Board sought to deal with issues such as eliminating three team districts, eliminating six team districts, consolidation and future consolidation, the number of schools in the ninth region as well as the number of schools in the sixth and seventh regions.
